BULLETIN NOTE

This bulletin supersedes the previous bulletin 01-020/07, issued on 05/24/07. The DESCRIPTION and WAR-RANTY INFORMATION have been revised.

DESCRIPTION

Some vehicles may experience MIL illumination with DTC P0455 stored in memory due to improperly tightened fuel filler cap.

- P0455 - EVAP System Leak Detected (Large Leak)

Some fuel filler pipes may be out of specification and in some cases, may not allow the fuel filler cap to be fully tightened. As a mass-production change, the shape of the fuel filler cap screw threads of fuel filler pipe have been modified.

The completion of MSP13 will address this concern in most cases so please be sure that it has been completed first. In the unlikely event that it does not, customers having this concern should have their vehicle repaired using the following repair procedure.

REPAIR PROCEDURE

- 1. Verify customer concern.
- 2. Replace the fuel filler pipe. Refer to appropriate Workshop Manual section 01-14 FUEL TANK REMOVAL / INSTALLATION.
- 3. Verify repair.
